

## National, Local & Private Scholarships

A number of scholarships & applications will ask for Elkhart Central High School's CEEB code. It is 150-915.

Scholarships with 2012 (or Fall 2011) deadline dates are accurate. Scholarships that have deadlines from Spring 2011 were left in for you to have an idea of when they might be due in 2012—**however, the dates could be very different. Check the deadline date that is on the application that you pick up!**
